<b>Font and font size:*</b>	Arial (11pt), Times New Roman (12pt), Cambria (12pt)
<b>Line spacing:</b>	1.5 lines
<b>Typeface:</b>	Left-justified or justified
<b>Number of pages:</b>	3 to 7 pages (cover sheet and statement of independence are not counted)
<b>Margins:</b>	Top and bottom 1.5 cm, left 2.2 cm, right 2.5 cm
<b>Page layout:</b>	The first page is the cover sheet. After that, a new page does not have to be new bullet point does not have to be started on a new page.
<b>Linguistic presentation:</b>	Logical, stringent presentation; clear and accurate expression; use of technical terms
