## Conditions regarding the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Class Trip

- The participant is bound to act according to the arrangements and assignments by the teacher or ski trip leader.
- The students may leave the group without a teacher for the purpose of recreation when accompanied by at least two other students, but only with the permission of a teacher.
- The participant must be healthy and physically able to participate in sports such as skiing and swimming. Please note: Your signature also permits the student to participate in activities such as sledding and hiking.
- In case of disobedience or unsocial behavior, the participant may be sent home immediately, and the <u>parents will pay all expenses</u>. The decision to send home a student is up to the ski trip leader.
- The privilege to participate in the trip may also be lost in the event of bad behavior prior to the trip.
- In case of sickness the parents will pay all expenses for medical treatment and transportation home (if necessary) if these expenses are not covered by insurance. Any medical expenses incurred by the ski trip leader in Bruck must be paid by the parents immediately after returning into the account listed below.
- Expenses caused by an accident during school related activities will be covered by the school insurance. Reports must be made to school offices especially if symptoms occur after we return from the trip. Please be aware that any further treatment upon our return to Berlin must be coordinated through a "Durchgangsarzt". This is a special licensed orthopedic and surgical doctor.
- The student is responsible for his/her own luggage and equipment. There is no insurance provided by the school.
- Prior to the trip parents should discuss with their child <u>rules about general behavior</u> and that <u>drinking alcohol, vaping and smoking are forbidden during the entire trip</u>!!
- The participant must bring a <u>valid passport</u> (or other travel document). Check the expiration date <u>NOW!</u>
- If not privately insured, also bring documents from your insurance company. It is also advisable to take out health insurance abroad.
- Withdrawal from the trip may lead to cancellation fees. Cancellation fees may also apply if the entire trip will be canceled.

- A payment of €715,- must be paid by February 1, 2024. Advanced skiers (students who can already use a lift) are asked to pay €25 additional lift fees. If skis, ski boots and a ski helmet have to be rented, please add € 75 to your payments.

- Please fill in the *registration* and *health declaration form* carefully and hand them in to your child's sport teacher by **December 6, 2023.**
- If your child can't participate in the ski trip, please inform the sports teacher <u>in writing</u>. Your child is then required to attend school for the duration of the class trip!
