Goals

- Opening minds to different cultural perspectives of the Spanish-speaking diaspora
- Communicative proficiency at the C1 / AP "5" level
- Lifelong appreciation and use of Spanish
- Providing an engaging platform through which students can realize their aspirations in Spanish at the highest level

Important Features

Core Elements

- Three years of prior instruction in the language (minimum)
- Hybrid Program: Taught in combination with Spanish Leistungskurs (LK)

Methodology

- Frequent opportunities to write a variety of compositions in the language
- Regular opportunities to develop speaking skills in a variety of settings
- Variety of authentic audio and/or video recordings that develop listening abilities
- Use of authentic materials to integrate the four language skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking)

- Modern Spain in Europe as Seen through Its Historical Development

12th grade-

- One World Global Issues: The Consequences of Immigration and Emigration
- Present-Day Challenges: The Coexistence of Different Cultures, Ethnic Groups, and Religions in Spain and Latin America


