English

1 Credit for each year of attendance at JFKS

- Required: English, German, Math, Science, US History, Sport
- Choices: Level of English, Math, Science, Sport, +elective(s)
-English: Grundkurs/regular or AP Literature (U.S.)
- Math: Algebra II, Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus AB (summer work)
- Science: Adv. Topics in Biology, Physics, AP Biology, AP Chemistry, AP Physics 1 and 2 (two exams)
-US History: Regular or APUSH

## Course Selections \& Future Plans

-Medicine, Engineering, STEM fields: choose multiple high-level sciences and math
-Politics, Law, History: high-level history, government, statistics, and English courses
-Computer Science/Technology: AP Computer Sciences, high-level math

European universities: always check requirements

## Using the Diploma in The United States

- The U.S. high school diploma is sufficient for admission to the vast majority of colleges and universities in the United States and Canada. The SAT or ACT may also be required
- Community Colleges - No AP courses/minimum GPA required
- Majority of 4-year Colleges and Universities - 3-4 AP courses over two years
- University of Oregon
- Arizona State University
- University of Colorado
- Highly Selective Colleges and Universities - 5-10 AP courses over two years + excellent grades, test scores, and extracurricular activities


## Using the Diploma in Germany

- US Diploma, 3.0 unweighted GPA (from $9^{\text {th }}$ Grade on)
- Minimum grade C (3-) in English, Math and Sciences. 2 credits of a second language.
- AP Exams to study Math, Sciences, Medicine, Pharmaceutics, Technology:
- 1 exam in Math (Calculus AB or BC) NOT Statistics
- 1 natural science (Biology, Chemistry, or Physics C - Electricity AND Mechanics)
- 1 language (French, Spanish, Latin, German, or English Literature or Langugage)
- 1 further subject (e.g. European History, U.S. History, Computer Science A)
- AP Exams to study the Arts, Humanities, Law, Psychology, Social Studies, Economics:
- 1 English (Literature or Language)
- 1 further additional language (German, French, Spanish or Latin)
- 1 math or science (Calc AB or BC, Biology, Chem or AP Physics C both exams)
- 1 further subject (e.g. European History, U.S. History, Computer Sci A)

Studienkolleg or Externe Feststellungsprüfung are other paths (without AP exams), but also require an unweighted 3.0 GPA

## Using the Diploma in The Netherlands

## Universities of Applied Science

- May accept a U.S. diploma (without AP's)
- Each diploma is individually evaluated - for specific degree programs

Research Universities

- University of Amsterdam: Diploma + 4 AP exams (score 3-5)
- PPLE: B+/3.33 GPA + 4 passing AP exams
- AP Calc AB, BC, or Statistics, B+ in AP English (Art AP's not accepted)
- Groningen: Diploma + 3.0 GPA + 3 AP exams (score 3-5)
- Media Studies
- Leiden University College: Liberal Arts \& Sciences: Global Challenges
- Diploma + unweighted 3.5 GPA + 3 AP exams (score 4-5) or 4 AP exams (score 3-5)
- Note: These examples of only a few programs and would be MINIMUM (not guaranteed) for Numerus Fixus programs. Requirements can change!


## Using the Diploma in The United Kingdom

University of Surrey: Psychology - 3 AP's with Scores of 5, 4, 4

University of Essex: Business Administration - 3.0 GPA, 3 in AP Calculus or 530 on SAT Math, 3 additional AP's at 4, 3, 3

Oxford University: Medicine - 4 AP's with a score of 5, including Chemistry and at least one of Biology, Physics, or Calculus + BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT) + interview
